Dr Raana Zeeshan shared the Haemophilia Center's experience with low dose prophylaxis which has a positive impact in reducing joint bleeds without an increase in inhibitors .

Prof. Lubna Zafar discussed the issues faced by Women with inherited bleeding disorders and the strategies to overcome these challenges .

Prof. Tahira Zafar presented the clinical scenarios of patients with severe vWD, haemophilia, Glanzmann's Thrombocythemia & F XIII deficiency.
